कलबी समाज के विद्यार्थियों को विभिन्न प्रतियोगी परीक्षाओं की वर्तमान पद्धतियों से अवगत कराकर उनमें सफलता सुनिश्चित कराने एवं विभिन्न क्षेत्रों में कैरियर के अवसरों की जानकारी देने के उद्देश्य से भविष्य ज्ञान ज्योति प्रतिभा खोज परीक्षा एवं कैरियर गाइडेंस सेमिनार का आयोजन संत श्री राजाराम भविष्य ज्ञान ज्योति फाउण्डेशन (रजिस्टर्ड) द्वारा राजस्थान के सभी कलबी बाहुल्य जिलों (जालोर, सिरोही, बाड़मेर, जोधपुर, पाली एवं जयपुर) में प्रतिवर्ष किया जाता है।

भविष्य ज्ञान ज्योति प्रतिभा खोज परीक्षा का प्रारम्भ वर्ष 2005 में श्री राजाराम कलबी समाज छात्रावास सांचौर (जालोर) में किया गया। तत्पश्चात इसको श्री राजाराम कलबी समाज छात्रावास जालोर में विस्तारित किया गया। सन् 2005 से 2012 तक इस परीक्षा का आयोजन जालोर एवं सांचौर में स्थित कलबी समाज के छात्रावासों में किया जाता रहा।

शैक्षिक सत्र 2013-14 से परीक्षा कार्यक्रम में महत्वपूर्ण बदलाव करते हुए यह परीक्षा राज्य स्तर पर कलबी समाज बाहुल्य जिलों के ब्लॉक स्तरीय, जिला स्तरीय व राज्य स्तरीय क्विज प्रतियोगिता तथा कैरियर गाइडेंस सेमिनार का आयोजन प्रतिवर्ष किया जा रहा है। इससे समाज के विद्यार्थियों में प्रतियोगी परीक्षाओं के प्रति जागरूकता बढ़ी फलस्वरूप इस परीक्षा में सहभागी रहे कई विद्यार्थी विभिन्न सरकारी सेवाओं में चयनित हुए।

शैक्षिक सत्र 2021-22 में भविष्य ज्ञान ज्योति परीक्षा आयोजन समिति को संस्थागत रूप देते हुए संत श्री राजाराम भविष्य ज्ञान ज्योति फाउण्डेशन के रूप में पंजीकृत करते हुए संस्थान सदस्यों एवं भामाशाहों के आर्थिक सहयोग से जरूरतमंद प्रतिभावान विद्यार्थियों के लिए छात्रवृत्ति के रूप में आर्थिक सम्बलन प्रदान करना प्रारम्भ किया।

इस वर्ष (2022-23) में इस परीक्षा का आयोजन 16 अक्टूबर, 2022 को राज्य के 33 परीक्षा केन्द्रों पर होने जा रहा है जिसमें कुल पंजीकृत विद्यार्थियों की संख्या 7950 है। इसके पश्चात जिला स्तरीय एवं राज्य स्तरीय क्विज प्रतियोगिता एवं कैरियर गाइडेंस सेमिनार क्रमशः जनवरी, 2023 व फरवरी 2023 में आयोजित किया जाना प्रस्तावित है। उक्त क्विज प्रतियोगिता एवं कैरियर गाइडेंस सेमिनार के माध्यम से जरूरतमंद विद्यार्थियों का चयन मई, 2023 में किया जाएगा।
